## Update: Pharmacists to Start Administering COVID-19 and Influenza Vaccines to Those Five Years of Age and Older

Please be advised that effective immediately Pharmacists that are certified to administer immunizations can now administer COVID-19 and Influenza vaccines to those five (5) years of age and older.

At this time, the expansion to administer vaccines down to age five (5) is only for COVID-19 vaccines and Influenza vaccines that are part of Manitoba's Seasonal Influenza Immunization Program. For all other vaccines, the age of administration for vaccines remains at 7 years of age and older.

The administration of these publicly-funded vaccines are to be within Manitoba's Immunization Program Policies, Protocols, and Guidelines located within the Immunization Program Manual at <a href="https://www.gov.mb.ca/health/publichealth/cdc/div/manual/index.html">www.gov.mb.ca/health/publichealth/cdc/div/manual/index.html</a>. Documentation within Manitoba's Immunization Program will be update in the future to reflect this updated policy.
