This circular provides information about a new Board Governance Manual and implementation support resources that will be provided to all licensed, non-profit child care centres in Manitoba.

Under the 2023-2025 Canada-Manitoba Early Learning and Child Care Agreement Action Plan, Manitoba has partnered with the Manitoba Child Care Association to develop leadership and governance training opportunities that will better support centre directors and board members to effectively fulfill their responsibilities.

In addition to *The Basics of Effective Board Governance: An Online Board Orientation Resource for Early Learning & Child Care Centres,* launched in 2018, all licensed non-profit centres in the province will have access to a customizable best-practice Board Governance Manual available in English and French. This will also include access to additional governance support and implementation assistance through People First HR Services at no cost to the facility.

As part of this initiative to strengthen Board governance supports, the Manitoba Child Care Association has also expanded their resource library to include more current governance resources available in both English and French.



Benefits:

The best-practice Board Governance Manual is an invaluable resource that supports effective board governance for all licensed not-for-profit centres. It is designed to:

- provide a comprehensive document outlining the responsibilities of a governing board and its members
- ensure consistency in board awareness throughout facilities in Manitoba
- offer flexibility to meet the unique needs of programs' governance framework and organizational needs
- serve as a reference for board training and orientation

The customizable manual, along with the individualized implementation support for your centre, reinforces the roles and responsibilities of both current and future centre management and boards regardless of their previous skills, knowledge and abilities. Both have a shared goal of ensuring that the organization is doing the right things; the best-practices Board Governance Manual serves to guide this partnership and its operations.
