

**2022 Spring Flood DFA Program – Manitoba
Veterinary Certificate of Probable Cause of Death**

On May 9, 2022 the Manitoba government announced Disaster Financial Assistance (DFA) for damages to infrastructure, private residences, farms or small businesses due to spring flooding. DFA will also assist with verified livestock losses. Under the DFA program criteria, a veterinary certificate is required to verify that the losses were a direct result of the event.
