

Join the Youth Leadership Council to have your voice heard.


Share your experiences and your thoughts with the minister of families

The minister of families is creating a Youth Leadership Council to hear directly from children and youth in Manitoba. The minister wants to make sure children and youth have a way of sharing their ideas, their lived experience, their concerns, and offer their voice to be reflected in government decisions.

The council will be composed of representatives from youth-service organizations, and youth aged **15-21** who have direct experience with **Department of Families** programs and services.
