2021/22	Major	A patient was not provided a regular medication while attending scheduled treatments and resulted in hospitalization.
2021/22	Major	A patient underwent an unnecessary surgical procedure.
2021/22	Major	Gaps existed in risk mitigation and interventions for a patient who developed a pressure related skin injury.
2021/22	Major	A patient, with specific dietary requirements, received an alternate diet resulting in a need for additional treatment and extension of their hospital stay.
2021/22	Major	A patient with a casted limb presented on different occasions to an Emergency Department (ED) with complications from the casting.
2021/22	Death	Patient developed a healthcare acquired infection associated with a serious outcome.
2021/22	Major	A patient experienced skin breakdown following discharge to community. Opportunities to mitigate risk of skin breakdown during discharge planning were missed.
2021/22	Death	A patient experienced a change in their health status after receiving a prescribed medication. The opportunity for earlier recognition and intervention was not realized.
2021/22	Major	Residents developed a healthcare acquired infection.
2021/22	Major	Specimens were received in laboratory. During diagnostics it became apparent specimens were switched. Patient was required to have a repeat biopsy.
2021/22	Major	Patient experienced an unnecessary surgical procedure due to misdiagnosis.
2021/22	Death	A patient experienced misinterpretation of imaging scans impacting their treatment plan.
