On motion of Hon. Mr. SWAN, Bill (No. 14) – The Body Armour and Fortified Vehicle Control Act/Loi sur le contrôle des gilets de protection balistique et des véhicules blindés, was read a First Time and had its purposes outlined.

The following petitions were presented and read:

Mr. DERKACH – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Provincial Government to consider proceeding with the cheaper, shorter and more logical east side route, subject to necessary regulatory approvals, to save ratepayers hundreds of millions of dollars during these challenging economic times. (F. McTavish, G. McTavish, E. Gurr others)

Mr. DYCK – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Minister of Health to ensure that patients who are awaiting placement in a personal care home are not moved to distant communities and to consider working with the RHA and the community to speed construction and expansion of long term care facilities in the region. (M. Evans, P. H. Toews, F. Friesen and others)

Mr. SCHULER – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to request that the Minister of Transportation consider the immediate installation of traffic signals at the intersection of PTH #15 and Highway #206 in Dugald and to recognize the value of the lives and well-being of the students and citizens of Manitoba. (A. Ruby, A. Killen, J. Schaap and others)

Mrs. DRIEDGER – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Minister of Health to consider rethinking her refusal to allow an ophthalmologist to practice in Swan River and to consider working with the community to provide this service without further delay. (V. Delaurier, D. Baldwin, D. Roberts and others)

Mr. GRAYDON – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Minister charged with the administration of the *Manitoba Public Insurance Corporation Act* to consider instructing MPI to allow claimants the right to select an independent claim representative of their choosing, whether paid or unpaid, whether a lawyer or non-lawyer, as claimants with similar claims in other provinces are permitted to do. (S. King, R. Hayden, K. Peattre and others)
