Whereas Application C01-13-136800 has been made to Council for a Conditional Use for property on NE 14-2-4E in the R.M. of Franklin;

And Whereas the Application requests to allow for the development of a Livestock operation with between 200 and 600 animal units;

Be it Resolved that Council approve the application with the following conditions:

- 1) The proponent is required to submit an "Application for Permit to Construct, Modify, or Expand a Manure Storage Facility" to Manitoba Conservation and Water Stewardship for each Manure Storage Facility (MSF) to be constructed;
- 2) Construction of a MSF shall not commence until a permit is granted by the Director, and adequate notification is given to Manitoba Conservation and Water Stewardship;
- 3) The proponent shall ensure the MSF, alone or in combination with other MSFs located on the property of the agricultural operation, is/are of sufficient capacity to store all livestock manure produced and used by the agricultural operation;
- 4) Livestock manure shall be stored until such a time that it can be applied as fertilizer;
- 5) The proponent must submit a Manure Management Plan (MMP) annually to Manitoba Conservation and Water Stewardship in accordance with the *Livestock Manure and Mortalities Management Regulation* (MR 42/98);
- 6) All unused and abandoned wells on the site and spread fields should be properly sealed and a sealed well report filed with the Groundwater Management Section of Conservation and Water Stewardship;

7) The proponent must ensure all setbacks requirements are observed in accordance with the *Livestock Manure and Mortalities Management Regulation* and *Nutrient Management Regulation* for livestock manure application;

8) In accordance with the *Livestock Manure and Mortalities Management Regulation*, the proponent must annually submit to Manitoba Conservation and Water Stewardship analytical results from samples of drinking water provided to their livestock;

9) The proponent should prepare a contingency plan in the event of a catastrophic event resulting in mass mortalities;

10) Manitoba Conservation and Water Stewardship requires that all deficiencies and issues regarding environmental performance identified by the professional engineer be addressed prior to populating the CLA with 300 AU or more.

11) All setback distances for wells of 100 meters be respected and no variances to this be allowed.

12) Proponent shall improve fencing to ensure livestock is contained within property.
