Delta II Boar Test Station Project

Please accept this Letter of Intent to supplement our Application for Conditional Use approval for a proposed Delta II Boar Test Station in the R.M. of Woodlands. See attached conceptual drawing.

We are proposing a \$9.0 - \$10.0 million "State of the Art" test station and barn facility that will include a sophisticated CT Scanner, computerized feed intake and high density phenotypic data collection system. We also propose a fully filtered intake ventilation system to ensure the highest level of bio-security.

The Delta II Boar test station is to be located on the E1/2 of NE 19-14-3W in a heavily wooded and secluded site. It will hold 1872 pig grow/finishers and 958 (AI) Boars totaling 459.3 Animal Units (AU).

Our Company's focus is on research and not production. Testing will include nutritional feed intake and feed conversion growth rates, and full body CT scanning for meat composition, fat ratio, skeletal structure, bone strength, and various other genetic traits of interest to the pork industry and to producers world-wide. Our goal is that this proposed facility in Woodlands would be the nucleus of "top genetics" for two genetics breeds.

When fully operational, roughly half the animals will be a testing phase while the other half (best of the best) will be selected for collection of semen for Artificial Insemination (AI) products. Both our AI products and live boars will be distributed to our Manitoba-based supply farms and also for export sales to over 50 countries world-wide with a focus on Europe and Asia.

In addition, Topigs Norsvin Canada has explored various collaborative academic and applied research initiatives with the University of Manitoba Agricultural Sciences Faculty. These initiatives are expected to be further supported at the proposed Delta II test station.

A bio-secure glass viewing gallery is to be a prominent feature in the new facility for academic and for international visitors and marketing purposes.

Our Boar test station project was presented to the Woodlands community at a Public Open House on September 8, 2016 at the Meadow Lea Hall. We are pleased that many residents at the Open House recommended we look to the Woodlands Community Pasture to select a project site; which we did. Since then we have kept the R.M. of Woodlands and the Woodlands community informed of our progress through various meetings and local media about the project. We now wish to make formal application for development approval.

We are hopeful that we may be given the privilege of developing in Woodlands and to become a good corporate citizen and long term neighbour in the community.
