CONDITIONAL USE ORDER NO. 06-MOC-18

Whereas John Waldner on behalf of Cool Spring Colony (beneficial owners) and the registered owners 2-81 Holding Co. Ltd. (collectively the "proponent") for the property legally described as being the South ½ Sec. 24, Twp. 16, Rge. 17 WPM, and the North ½ Sec. 13, Twp. 16, Rge. 17 WPM, in the Rural Municipality of Minto-Odanah, applied to the Council in accordance with Section 111(1) of the Planning Act, for approval of a conditional use in order to authorize the expansion of the existing poultry production portion of an existing livestock production operation. The application is for the construction of a broiler chicken barn and a multi-purpose barn.
