CONDITIONAL USE ORDER NO. 07-MOC-19

Whereas John Waldner on behalf of Cool Spring Colony (beneficial owners) and the registered owners 2-81 Holding Co. Ltd. (collectively the "proponent") for the property legally described as being the South ½ Sec. 24, Twp. 16, Rge. 17 WPM, in the Rural Municipality of Minto-Odanah, applied to the Council in accordance with Section 111(1) of the Planning Act, for approval of a conditional use in order to authorize the expansion of the existing poultry production portion of an existing livestock production operation. The application is for the construction of a broiler chicken barn and a multi-purpose barn. The application would expand the livestock production operation from its existing 65,575 animals (1043.75 A.U.) to 97,479 animals (1218 A.U., an increase of 174 A.U., in accordance with the provisions of the Rural Municipality of Minto Zoning By-law No. 2/04;


