This order shall expire, if not acted upon within 12 months of the date of making.

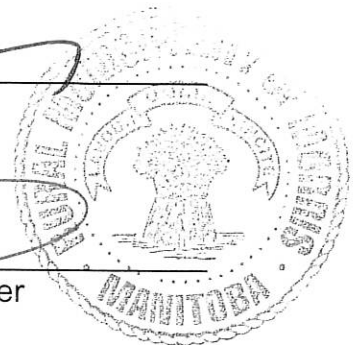

Approval is given subject to the property owner being responsible for the following conditions:




