Thanks for the opportunity to respond RE Sunnybrook Swine Inc TRC-12-104 expansion to 4500 sows.

Our goal is to have the expansion be contained within the existing yard space that is protected by trees on the south, east and north side of the property site. We plan to straw cover the primary cell of the lagoon to reduce the odour during the summer months. We do our best to manure apply in the fall after harvest or in the spring before seeding depending on the year and field conditions. When injecting the manure, we use umbilical hose to pump manure and the manure is injected directly in the soil to reduce the odour and increase the nutrient value of the manure for the crop. Presently it takes 2-3 days to do our existing manure application and our expectation with the expansion is that the application would be 3-4 days. We currently use and plan to use a professional agrology service to manage our manure in accordance with all applicable regulations.
