

FOREST SERVICE PROVISIONS

Operations directly or indirectly connected with this Contract are subject to the provisions of:

The Forest Act and Regulations; and
The Fires Prevention Act

In general, the following provisions will allow the Contractor to comply with the Provisions of these Acts and Regulations, and final payment on this Contract will not be made until written clearance has been obtained from the supervising Forest Officer in respect to;

1. General

The Contractor shall keep a record of forest products manufactured in the manner required and in the books supplied by the supervising Forest Officer.

Where clearing off the right-of-way is necessary, in respect to tote roads, camps or storage sites, or for any other purpose, all provisions and specifications set forth in this Contract shall apply to such extra clearing.

The Contractor shall keep camp and storage sites in a clean and sanitary condition and the Contractor shall comply with any special written instructions which the Forest Officer may issue in respect to The Forest or Fire Prevention Acts.

When burning operations on or off the right-of-way result in fire becoming established in logs, stumps or in the ground, the Contractor shall extinguish all such fire to the satisfaction of the Forest Officer.

2. Close Season Provisions

Close season is the period from the 15th day of April to the 15th day of November.

All provisions contained in Part 1 of these instructions shall be carried out during the Close Season. In addition, the following provisions shall be carried out;

- a) No burning shall be done except under a Burning Permit, which may be issued by the supervising Forest Officer.
- b) Conditions set forth in a Burning Permit will become part of the provisions of this Contract.
- c) During the close season, in "Wooded Areas", all clearing and grubbing operations shall be conducted;
 - from an established camp at which not less than ten men shall be employed and each camp shall be under direct charge of a foreman.
 - with a full-time fire patrolman employed continuously on the operation conducted from each camp.
 - with such fire fighting tools and equipment as may be specified by the Forest Officer, being provided and kept in readiness.
 - when fire occurs on or spreads from any operation connected with this Contract, the Contractor shall;
 - (i) forthwith, with all employees tools and equipment, control and extinguish such fire,
 - (ii) immediately notify the nearest fire guardian,
 - (iii) on arrival of a fire guardian, place himself, his employees, tools and equipment under the direction of such fire guardian during the period such fire is being controlled or extinguished.
