

AGREEMENT

RE: OWNERSHIP, CONFIDENTIALITY AND USE OF TRADITIONAL KNOWLEDGE INFORMATION

Whereas: Your community has provided Traditional Knowledge (TK) information to ESRA and its consultants for the purposes of a Traditional Knowledge study to be used for the East Side Road Project.

Whereas: ESRA has acknowledged that the TK information is the property of your community and its members and has committed to keep this information confidential.

Whereas: ESRA has committed to use the TK information for the purposes of the East Side Road Project to inform the design, construction and environmental approvals for the all season road network, winter road network and future discussion with your community.

Whereas: ESRA has committed to return all original materials (maps, and notes) to the community with the permission of the people interviewed.

Whereas: ESRA has acknowledged that the TK information is the property of your community and its members and has committed to keep this information confidential.

Whereas: ESRA has committed that confidential information that is collected for the study will be held in confidence and will not be published, revealed or disclosed to those not involved in the course of conducting the project. Information that has been provided may only be used by ESRA, its employees, and agents in relation to the east side road project.

Whereas: ESRA is being incorporated into Manitoba Infrastructure (MI).

Be it resolved that:

MI commits to the terms of the original agreement including:

- That the information provided will be used exclusively for the East Side Road Project
- MI will continue to keep this information confidential and will not release any information to other government departments, regulatory bodies, or other outside parties without the prior written consent of the First Nation Chief and Council.
- When the East Side Road project is complete, ESRA/MI will destroy copies of the TK survey and mapping information. Information relevant to ongoing maintenance activities will be retained on file.
