What is the project about?



The bridge over Brokenhead River on PTH 59 crosses through the lands of Brokenhead Ojibway Nation.

The PTH 59 bridge has exceeded its design life.

This crossing is a necessary connection for community members, local businesses, industry, and travellers to access services and many recreation, leisure, homes and cottages across the river.

To address the need for replacement, the Province is undertaking a design project, along with engineers from Dillon Consulting Ltd., and engagement specialists from Scatliff + Miller + Murray (SMM).
