In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125) this Licence is issued to:

Canadian Pacific Railway: "the Licencee"

for the construction and maintenance of the Development being a stabilization of the east bank of the Red River at Mile 124.6 of the Keewatin Subdivision near Archibald Avenue in Winnipeg. The Development consists of drainage improvements and slope flattening as well as the construction of a rockfill shear key. The Development is subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development on lands described on the following plans:

North of CP Rail Right of Way:

Plan 23803, Lot 2; Elmwood Road Right of Way

CP Rail Right of Way (approximately 40 m on each side of centreline of tracks)

Plan 5224, Lot 1

South of CP Rail Right of Way:

Plan 5224, Lot 2; Plan 7297, approximately 60 m by 20 m adjacent to Archibald Right of Way.

- 2) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with methods outlined in the Environment Act Proposal dated November 25, 1992, as modified by the "Design Modifications" contained in the letter dated January 19, 1993, both submitted to Manitoba Environment by KGS Group on behalf of the Licencee.
- 3) The Licencee shall reseed exposed soil with an erosion resistant mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 4) The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.

Revocation

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the specifications, limits, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
