In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

**The Ste. Elisabeth Water Co-op Ltd.: "the Licencee"**

for the construction and operation of the Development being a municipal well and water distribution project in the Rural Municipality of De Salaberry subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

**Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions**

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated April 26, 1993, submitted by the Manitoba Water Services Board on behalf of the Licencee.
- 2) The Licencee shall construct the river crossing of the Marsh River south of 36-4-2E by boring, tunneling or auguring under the riverbed as described in the Proposal. The Licencee shall not undertake any method of river or stream crossing other than that authorized by this Licence without prior written approval from the Director.
- 3) The Licencee shall ensure that the construction of the Development does not disturb riparian zone vegetation adjacent to the Marsh River crossing site.
- 4) The Licencee shall stabilize and re-vegetate any areas of soil disturbed by the construction of the Development which could erode and produce sedimentation in the Marsh River.
- 5) The Licencee shall obtain all necessary permits and agreements from Manitoba Highways and Transportation and the Highway Traffic Board prior to undertaking construction on or adjacent to highway rights-of-way.
- 6) The Licencee shall ensure that the operation of the municipal water supply is in accordance with Manitoba Regulations under the Public Health Act and all operating requirements as recommended by Manitoba Environment.
- 7) The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.

- 8) The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.

### REVOCATION

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
