A site plan showing the additions and deletions in red has been attached for Manitoba Sustainable Development's files.

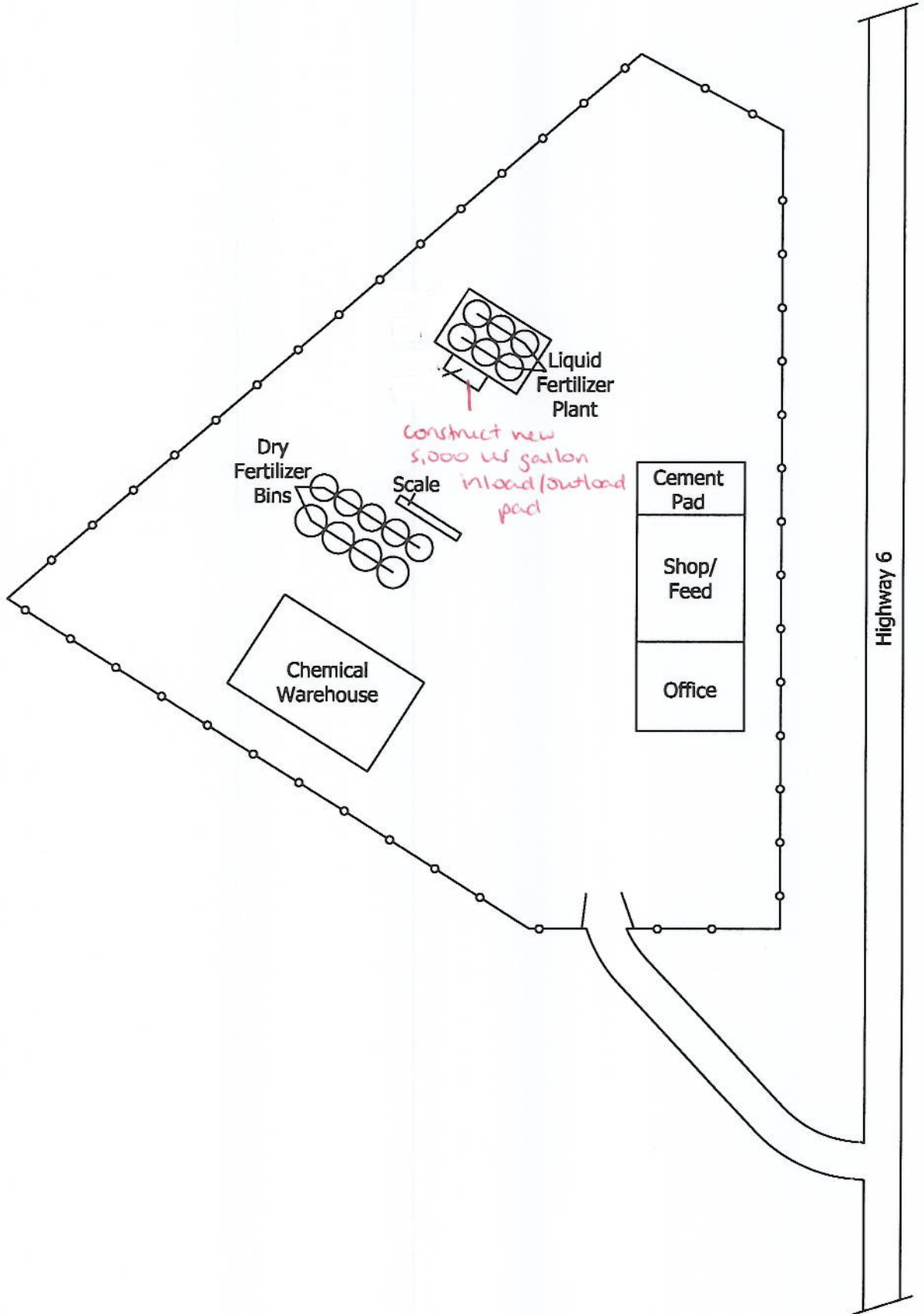
Identification and Quantification of Changes to the Type or Quantity of Raw Materials or Substances Used or Processed

Quantification of Change in the Environmental Effects as a Result of the Alteration

With no anticipated changes to the production rate, no significant changes in the environmental effects are anticipated from the alteration of this development. Respecting liquid fertilizer spillage, the proposed upgrades should reduce the spillage from normal operation. This coupled with the timely cleanup of any minor spillage that may occur during normal operation should contain all product.
