Re: Kitchen Craft – Introduction of Paint Spray Machine for Door Insert Panels

Thank you for the Notice of Alteration (NoA) submitted on July 19, 2013 that described the conversion of the door insert panels staining process from manual to an automated system. The alteration also will involve the installation of a new stack that will vent through the roof. The proposed alteration will result in lower VOC releases due to a reduction in the amount of color stains used in the process.

Upon review of your alteration request, I have concluded that the environmental effects from the NoA will be insignificant, and therefore in accordance with Section 14(2) of *The Environment Act* you are hereby authorized to carry out the proposed alteration as described in the July 19, 2013 NoA. The following condition will apply.

1. Within 60 days of the completion of the proposed alteration, an updated roof plan indicating all existing and new vents through the roof shall be submitted.
