

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* from the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

MANITOBA HYDRO - HARROW STATION TO BISHOP GRANDIN BLVD. TRANSMISSION PROJECT - FILE: 5766.00

A proposal has been filed by Manitoba Hydro for relocating and rebuilding two 115 kV double circuit transmission lines by upgrading the lines with new towers and conductors between Harrow Station (Harrow Street and Taylor Avenue) and Bishop Grandin Boulevard. The project will be constructed along 5km of the existing right of way owned by Manitoba Hydro. The anticipated in-service date is summer 2016.
