

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

R.M. OF HANOVER - GRUNTHAL - KLEEFELD RURAL WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM **- FILE: 5812.00**

An Environment Act Proposal has been filed by the Manitoba Water Services Board on behalf of the Rural Municipality of Hanover for a rural water supply pipeline connecting Grunthal and Kleefeld along PTH 216. Treated water for Kleefeld would be supplied from the Grunthal water supply and treatment system, and the existing groundwater supply for the Kleefeld water distribution system would be discontinued. The combined groundwater withdrawal for both communities is anticipated to be 406 dam³/year by the year 2034, with an average demand of 13.1 litres per second. Construction and operation of the supply system is proposed for 2016.
