## Canadian Navigable Waters Act

The Government of Manitoba hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for approval of the work described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, The Government of Manitoba has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<a href="http://cps.canada.ca/">http://cps.canada.ca/</a>) and under registry number **11437**, or, under the NPP File Number **2024-613237**, a description of the following work, its site, and plans:

## Pedestrian Bridge

In, on, over, under, through or across an inlet to West Hawk Lake (a non-scheduled waterway) in Whiteshell Provincial Park, Manitoba

At Southwest/Southeast Section 15, Township 9, Range 17E1

However, comments will be considered only if they are in writing (electronic means preferable) and are received not later than 30 days after the publication of last notice. Although all comments conforming to the above will be considered, no individual response will be sent.
