

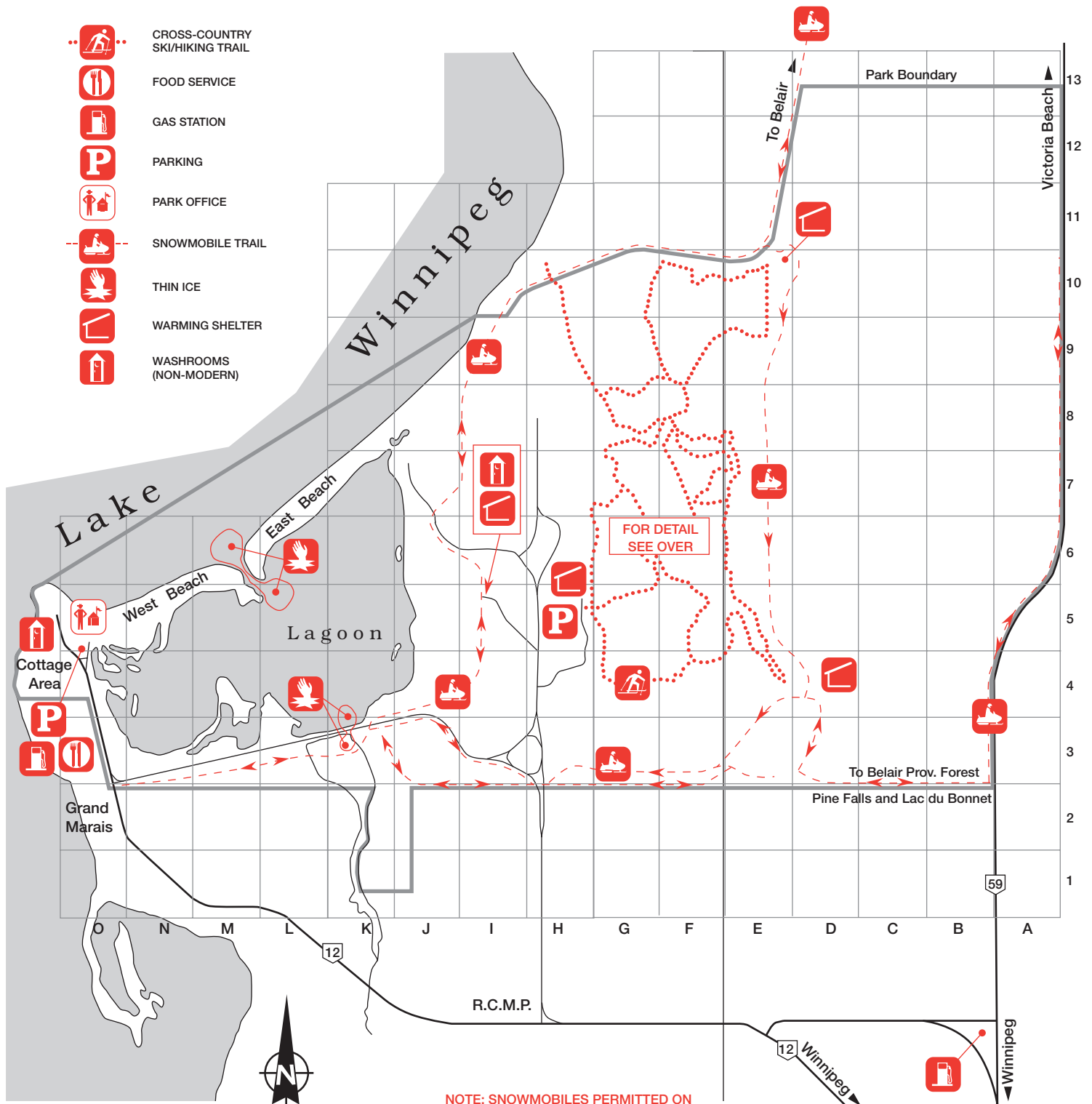

Trail Tips and Regulations

- Respect all trail users.
- Skiers have the right of way.
- Never step on groomed ski tracks. Keep all walking, snowshoeing, biking and dogs on shared use trails ONLY. If sinking more than 1 inch, wear snowshoes if walking or lower tire pressure if fat biking.
- Observe trail designations and direction of travel.
- Dogs must be kept on leash and always clean up after your pet.
- Observe signs and pay attention to your surroundings as you travel.
- No overnight use.
- Practice Leave No Trace – take only pictures, leave only footprints. Pack and take all litter out with you.

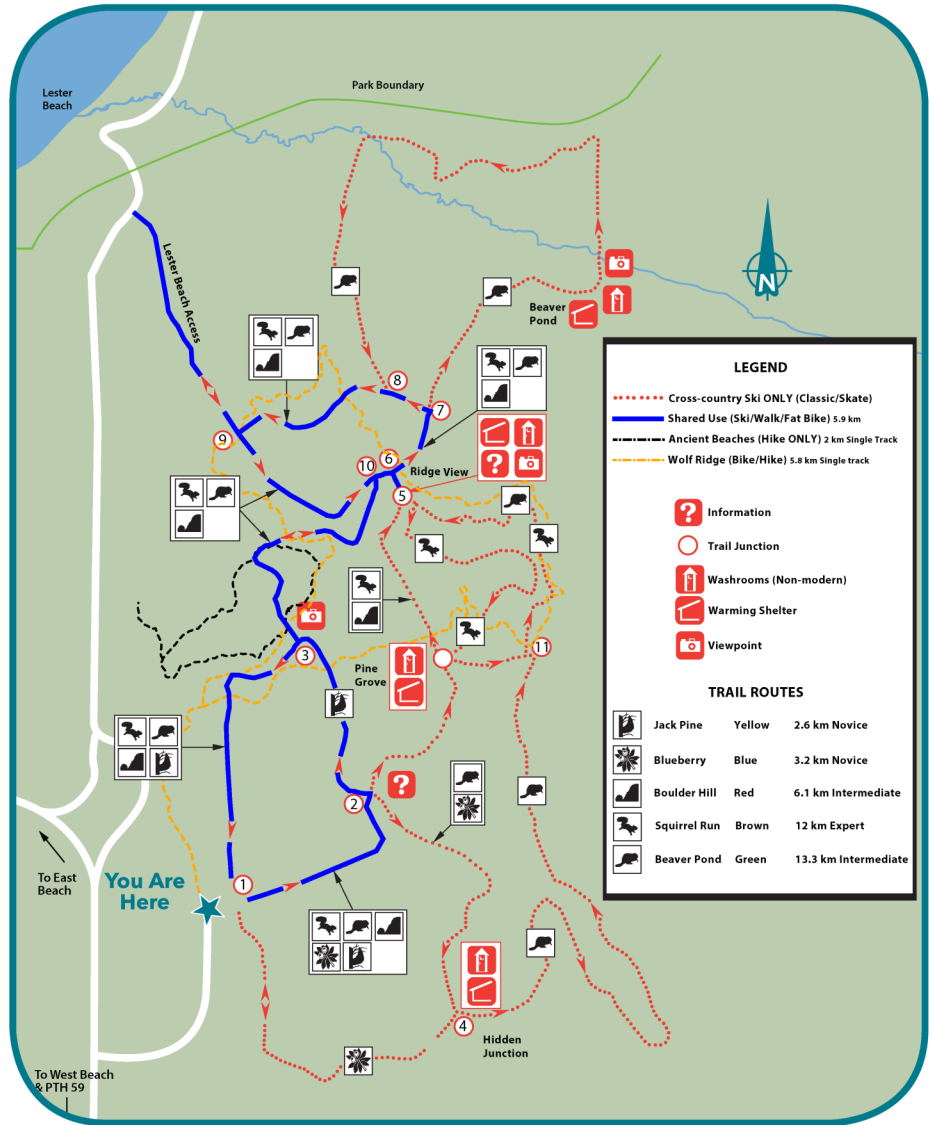
