

# Labour Market Partnerships

## Partnering with communities, sector associations and employers to address labour market needs

Training and Employment Services (TES) provides funding for activities under the following three categories:

- **Workforce Development Services (Employee/Employer Focussed)** – workforce adjustment (layoffs and job-threatened) and workforce expansion (new hires) activities
- **Labour Market Development Services (Community Focussed)** – including human resource planning, labour market analysis, and training infrastructure development
- **Labour Force Development Services (Sector Focussed)** – including human resource planning, training infrastructure development, and activities that promote and support sector-specific opportunities

## What activities are eligible?

### Funding may be provided for projects that:

- Support workforce development and adjustment activities to assist employers, employee associations and job threatened workers to deal with workforce changes
- Assist employers to improve their capacity to implement workforce expansion
- Support labour market development activities in communities that identify and create employment opportunities and address labour market supply and demand needs
- Support labour force development activities that help identify and address human resource and training needs in specific sectors

## Who can apply for funding?

The following private, public and community sector organizations are eligible contractors:

- For-profit businesses
- Not-for-profit organizations
- Federal/provincial Crown corporations
- Public health and education institutions
- Municipal governments
- Band or tribal councils

- Unions and labour groups
- Sector associations
- Professional associations
- Employee associations
- Private sector employer groups

Labour Market Partnerships proposals are assessed based on the needs of the labour market, TES priorities, and the availability of funds.
